

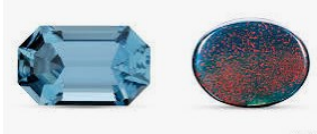

March Facts

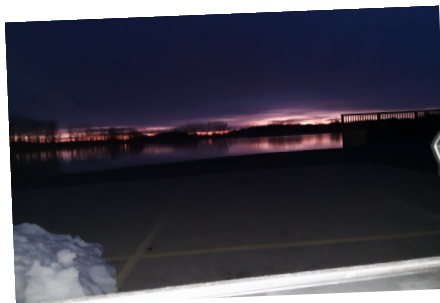
- * Birthstone is Aquamarine and Bloodstone

How to Dewinterize your RV-We are ready are you?

It's finally time to bring your RV out of storage you will need to Dewinterize your RV.

- ◆ Check your Tires-Your tires will lose about 2-3 psi each month in storage.
- ◆ Inspect the Exterior-Do you have damages, Leaks or Cracks-check your weather stripping around windows and doors. Check roof and Slide-outs
- ◆ Charge and reinstall your batteries.
- ◆ Flush your Water System
- ◆ Sanitize your Water System
- ◆ Check for Leaky Pipes
- ◆ Reinstall or Replace Propane tanks if needed.
- ◆ Check your Propane appliances
- ◆ Test 120-volt Appliances
- ◆ Check the Engine-Check all fluid levels, do you need a oil change
- ◆ Test your RV Generator
- ◆ Change Filters-Air and Water this Improves efficiency.
- ◆ Check Air Vents
- ◆ Check your safety Devices-smoke alarm, fire extinguisher, carbon monoxide detector. Install new batteries
- ◆ Restock First Aid and Emergency
